Glowsticks FAQ

Where can I sell glowsticks?

- Alice at ESCA can book you a slot at the Big Cheese on a Saturday night.
 - o Three people can get in for free and jump the queue.
- If you want to sell at another venue, we can provide glowsticks and buckets but you must liaise with the venue yourselves.

Where do I get the glowsticks?

• You can collect them from the Activities Office in Potterrow.

What other important information do I need to know?

- The names of people fundraising at the Big Cheese must be emailed to Alice before Thursday 5pm.
- We can lend you a bucket.
 - You MUST make a label with the name & UK charity number of the charity/society/sports club clearly displayed and put this on the bucket.
 - We will give you cable ties which MUST be used to secure the bucket lid while collecting
 - Buckets & leftover glowsticks you want to return MUST be handed in to the Activities
 Office the next working day
 - o Otherwise the cost will be deducted from your fundraising total.

What do I do with the money raised?

- We will give you a money bag to transfer the money into at the end of the night.
- If fundraising at the Big Cheese
 - o The money **MUST** be handed to the night manager (ask for him/her at the cloakroom) and they will put it into the safe.
 - There is a form to be completed when you hand over the money, this must be returned to the Activities Office the next working day
- If fundraising at another venue the money **MUST** be handed in to the Activities Office the next working day
- We will then count and bank the money and pay it out to your charity

How much do the glowsticks cost?

- The glowsticks are £3 for a pack of 100.
- Headband connectors that can be used to make bunny ears are 15p each
- The cost of these items is taken from your fundraising total.

Who can I fundraise for?

• You can fundraise for any U.K registered charity or your sports club or society.
